"I can't be seen drinking!" protested the nun.

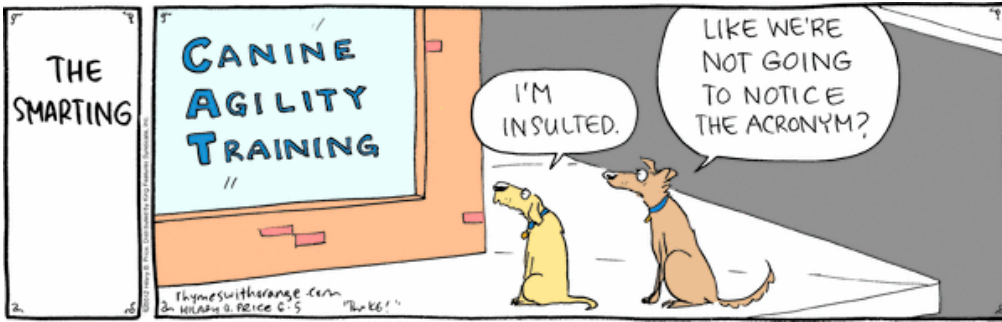
"Well, I'll get it in a teacup for you." And the man went into the bar and ordered vodka in a teacup.
