Paddy: I've already got one rabbit at home!

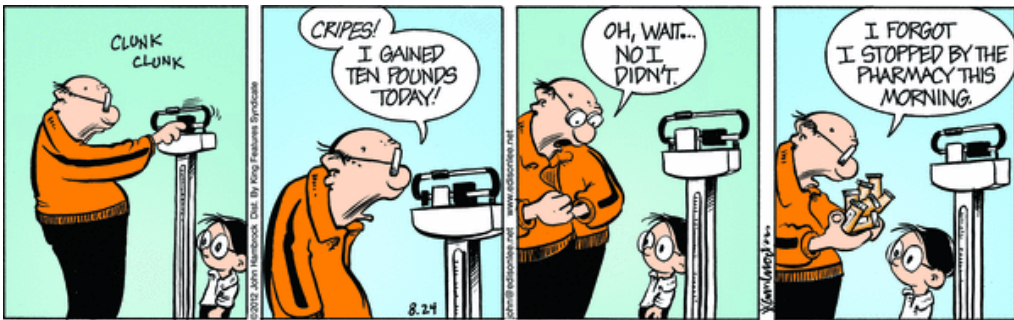
Cereal was invented when colonial housewives started serving up popcorn with sugar and cream for breakfast.
