The NFL awards Super Bowl rings to the losing team that played in the Super Bowl as well. The losing team receives up to 150 rings. There are some stipulations on these rings though, to keep the ones given to the Super Bowl Champions more prestigious. The total value spent on the losing team's Super Bowl rings can not be more than half of what is spent on the winning team's rings.

The coldest game in NFL history was the 1967 NFL Championship Game between the Dallas Cowboys and the Green Bay Packers. Now known as the "Ice Bowl," the game-time temperature in Green Bay was -13F degrees with a -48 degree wind chill.

The winning team in the Super Bowl receives permanent possession of the sterling silver Vince Lombardi trophy. The trophy stands 20.75 inches tall, weighs 107.3 ounces, and is valued in excess of \$25,000.

The last player to play without a helmet in the NFL was Chicago Bears lineman Dick Plasman. He went helmet-less from 1937 until 1941. He then enlisted in the military to serve during World War II. Plasman played three more years after his service but used a helmet because the equipment became mandatory in 1943.

In 1892 a touchdown was worth four points while a field goal was worth five points. In 1897 the TD increased to five points. In 1904 and '09 a field goal was reduced to four then three points respectively. Finally in 1912, the TD increased to 6 points.

The NFL, first known as the American Professional Football Association, was formed in Canton on Sept. 17, 1920. Until the early 1930s, the league champion was crowned based on the best win-loss record in the regular season. The champion in the league's inaugural season was the 8-0-3 Akron (Ohio) Pros.

Players with Super Bowl & Grey Cup Rings[

A select few have competed in both the NFL and Canada's equivalent CFL winning rings in both leagues.

O.J. Brigrance won a Grey Cup ring in 1995 with the CFL's Baltimore Stallions and won a Super Bowl ring in 2001 with the Baltimore Ravens. He is the only player to win both a Grey Cup and a Super Bowl with teams from the same city.

Harald Hasselbach won a ring in 1992 with CFL's Calgary Stampeders and won a Super Bowl ring in 1997 with the Denver.

Tyrone Williams won two Super Bowl rings with Dallas in 1992 and 1993, though he did not participate in either game. He then won a Grey Cup ring with the Toronto Argonauts in 1996.

Alvin Walton (Safety) won two Super Bowl rings with the NFL's Washington Redskins (1987 and 1991 seasons, but did not participate in the 1991 season 37-24 Super Bowl victory over the Buffalo Bills) and won a Grey Cup ring with the Baltimore Stallions in 1995.

Bobby Singh (Guard) is the only player to win a Grey Cup (2006 with the BC Lions), Super Bowl (1999 with the St. Louis Rams), and the XFL Championship (2001 with the Los Angeles Xtreme)
