California-based Pacific Gas & Electric Co. suffered a catastrophic explosion in a gas line in San Bruno in 2010. The 30-inch diameter pipe had been installed in the 1950s, and its explosion sent flames 1,000 feet into the sky; emergency responders at first thought a jet had crashed, and Bay Area seismographs recorded the explosion as an earthquake. Dozens of houses were destroyed but amazingly, only eight people were killed. PG&E had also been given permission to spend \$5 million for the same work in 2007. The work has never been done, and the PUC has proposed a record \$1.6 billion fine against the company.
