D. Braxton asks: Is it safe to eat mouldy bread or mouldy cheese?

For the quick answer to your question: no and sometimes. While not all moulds are bad for you to eat, many are, and unless you want to whip out a microscope and meticulously identify the mould present on your food (note: there are 300,000 known types and counting), as a general rule it's better to avoid mouldy foods. With respect to bread and cheese, it's important to understand that the visible mould you see on the surface of bread and cheese also sends root threads down into the food. In moulds that are bad for you, these threads often have poisonous substances in and around these 'roots'.
